- 1. registry tweaks might disable touchscreen functionality for that user.

Fix:

Press Win + R, type regedit, and go to:

HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Microsoft\Wisp\Touch

Look for TouchGate and ensure it's set to 1 (or delete it if unsure).

Restart your PC.
